What are NVQs ?

NVQs or National Vocational Qualifications are practical qualifications that are achieved largely by what you do in your job. The rules, or "standards", of the qualifications are designed by the industry that the qualification relates to.

There are five NVQ levels which you can work towards depending on your job:

Level 1 Basic Industry Skills.

Level 2 Enhanced Industry Skills.

Level 3 Junior Management.

Level 4 Middle Management.

Level 5 Senior Management.

NVQs are made up of Units and Knowledge.

What are the units?

NVQs are split into units, each of which represents an area of work. The qualification will have a mixture of Mandatory and Optional units. Your Learning Assessor will match the Optional units to your job role to make sure that your qualification is just right for you.

What is the Knowledge?

It is important that you have the knowledge to support your work activities, i.e. you need to understand why you are doing something and what would happen if you didn't. In other words you are proving that you can do the job (units) and showing your understanding of why you are doing the job in the way you do it (knowledge).

How do I complete the units and demonstrate the knowledge I have?

With the support of your Manager and your Learning Assessor you can collect evidence from your everyday tasks and responsibilities at work and build a portfolio of evidence. Evidence can be collected in a variety of ways:

Professional discussions with you.

Photographs.

Question and Answer sessions.

Examples of your everyday work and responsibilities.

Customer and management testimonial.

Observations and Case Studies.

It is important to know that to achieve your Award your evidence must be:

Valid.

Produced by you.

Sufficient to meet awarding body standards.

What is an Apprenticeship ?

Apprenticeships provide a mixture of on and off-the-job training whilst in employment. They encompass an NVQ, Key Skills and a Technical Certificate, and have two levels:

Apprenticeships

Equivalent to GCSEs and include an NVQ level 2, Key Skills and sometimes a Technical Certificate

Advanced Apprenticeships

Equivalent to A Levels and include an NVQ level 3, Key Skills and a Technical Certificate

What are Key Skills?

Key Skills are a generic set of skills that are required for any job role and include Communication and Application of number.

What are Technical certificates?

The technical certificate is designed to test occupational knowledge and understanding. They are delivered through a taught programme of off-the-job training, unlike NVQs, which are delivered through on-the-job training. Technical certificates may be existing qualifications such as Foundation Health and Safety in Hospitality or new qualifications developed to meet the needs of a particular sector, e.g. Food Hygiene.

All learners completing Apprenticeship programmes will be awarded the relevant NVQ, Key Skills and Technical Certificate.
